Microwave Dish


Do you need a dish for microwave activity?

Alan was one of the original QDG members; he was on the committee for many years. Alan was the mentor of many and I'm proud to have counted him among my friends, he will never be forgotten.



The DATV-Express Project

The DATV-Express is a digital Amateur TeleVision exciter/transmitter (assembled board with software) that can operate on ham radio bands from 70 MHz to 2.45 GHz.

The most important concept about the DATV-Express board is that it is software-based SDR radio. While the system block diagram for a typical Digital-ATV DVB-S transmitter using the DATV-Express board is shown below, the modulator chip and software can also produce several other types of modulations and protocols, such as COFDM for DVB-T and 32APSK for DVB-S2. http://www.datv-express.com/



Skywave Linux

New Linux Ubuntu Distribution made for Software Defined Radio

Skywave Linux is a new Linux distribution based on Ubuntu 14.10. It is designed for users of software defined radio's and comes with several useful SDR software packages preinstalled. It can be run from a bootable DVD, USB or SD card.

The author writes that Skywave Linux is currently compatible with the RTL-SDR and HPSDR hardware. At the moment it seems that the first version has only very few preinstalled software

programs. These include: QT Radio, CubicSDR, Fldigi, and Dump1090. The authors write about Skywave:
