Amateur Radio And Electromagnetic Radiation Issues

What is EMR ?

Electromagnetic radiation is familiar to us all as sunlight, heat, X-rays and radio waves.

Electromagnetic radiation (EMR) conveys energy from a source to distant places. For example, the Sun radiates light, heat and other varieties of electromagnetic energy, which is received here on Earth. Your amateur transmitter conveys radiofrequency (RF) energy via your antenna to other amateurs' antennas and their receivers detect that energy and convert it to sound.
